# WINNERS, WINNERS, AND MORE WINNERS

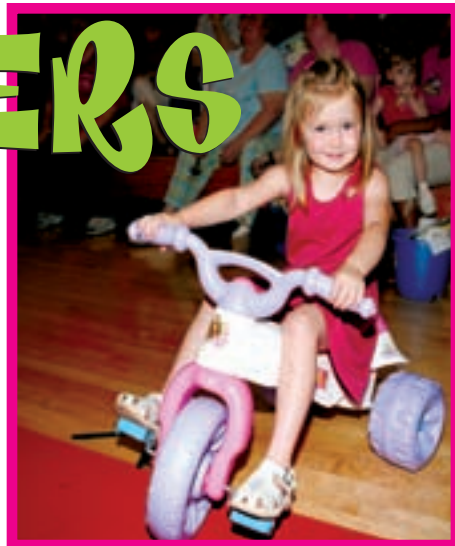

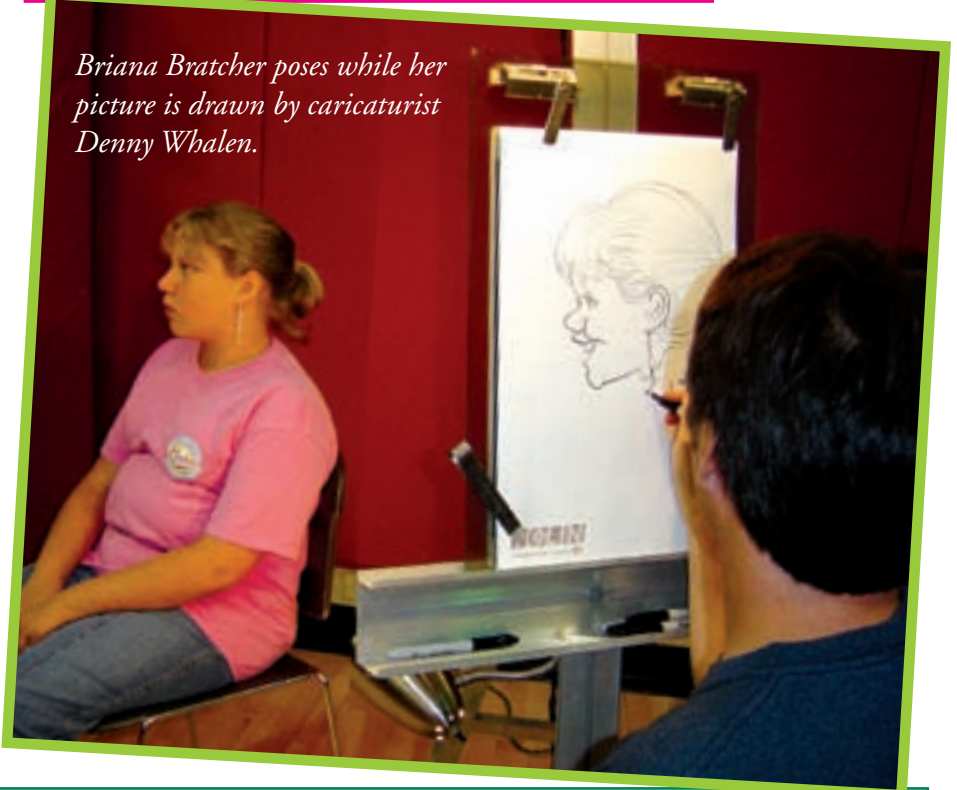
## New Member Credits
