Participation Requirements: **High School:** _____

1. Students must be a senior with intentions of graduating in the Spring of 2010 and planning to enroll full-time in college or vocational school.
2. Participants must be from the Nolin RECC service area and their parents or legal guardian must be a Nolin member whose primary residence is in the Nolin service territory.
3. Previous scholarship winners, Nolin RECC employees, directors, or anyone receiving direct benefits from the co-op, and members of their immediate families, are not eligible for any scholarship awards.
4. Six \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

*Grade Point Average (25%)
School Involvement (15%)*

*Community and Personal Achievements (15%)
Legitimate Financial Need (45%)*

Recipients must use scholarships within two (2) years of receiving the award.
